[April 23 2005] – Version 0.6

Fixed a bug where the refresh function did not work with a space in the configured Mime server. Changed minor code, titles and text messages.

[April 22 2005] – Version 0.5

Double Clicking the System Tray Utility now automatically refreshes the SoftGrid Application List.

[March 18 2005] – Version 0.4

Fixed crashes when recalling the About screen a couple of times. Improved "Refresh" function.

[March 10 2005] – Version 0.3 (first public release)

I decided to make this utility a System Tray utility. This way i will try to make it a more end-user friendly utility which can be deployed along side the SoftGrid Client for Windows Desktops and Terminal Server.

[November 16 2004] – Version 0.2 (no public release)

I added the "Clear Cache" button which clears the complete SoftGrid Client Cache including all personal settings of the user clicking this button. See the "How to" tab to see how to get it working.

[October 1 2005] – Version 0.1 (no public release)

Just created this tool for myself because i was doing a lot of Sequencing and testing. The only button was the "Refresh" button which refreshes the SoftGrid application list.

System Requirements:

Softgrid SoftGrid Client 3.1 or higher installed on each machine you wish to use this utility.

.Net Framework 1.1 or higher installed on each machine you wish to use this utility.

Latest version tested with:

Windows XP Professional with SoftGrid Client 3.1.0.334, 3.1.2.14 and 3.2.0.170 (Beta 2)

Windows 2003 Terminal Services with SoftGrid Client 3.1.0.334 and 3.1.2.14

How To Use the SoftGrid System Tray Utility:

Simple; The automated setup will install a shortcut in the Programs\Startup folder so the utility will automatically start upon logon. There will be a new Systray icon available shown in the illustration below:



You can also double click on the System Tray icon to "Refresh SoftGrid Applications" List.
